## Quamba Company Will Build in Mora

Mora's business scene continued to expand this week with the announcement that a new lumber yard would open for business here some time this summer.

Emil Oslin, mayor of Quamba and proprietor of Rudd Lumber company in that village, said that he would begin a lumber business in Mora as soon as construction can be completed.

Oslin, Quamba lumberman for the past 28 years, said that he would maintain the Rudd Lumber company as well as the new operation in Mora.

The yard here will be located east of the village on the Nels Norstrom farm. Oslin will move his Quamba home to Mora but as far as the amount or size of business buildings to be constructed here, his plans were still in the tentative stages.

The original lumber yard was owned by S. S. Patterson of Princeton and later operated by M. K. Rudd until Oslin purchased the business.
